All Distinguished Guests to be introduced must register with the Credential Committee prior to introductions.

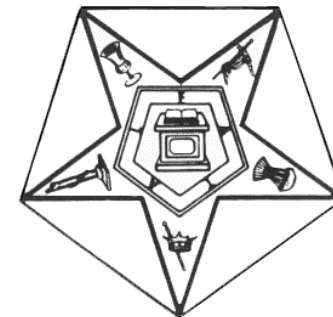
Junior Past Matrons of N.B. are asked to wear an evening gown for the Informal Opening on Thursday evening.
