It is with sadness that we announce the passing of Sister Ethel Tweedie, PGM at the age of 93. She was born in Sackville NB, the daughter of the late Harry and Evelyn Ison. In her later years she was a resident of the Rexton Lions Nursing Home where she passed away peacefully on Thursday October 10, 2013.
